1 Ref: C1_RFP317

Question:

Based on the proposed timelines within the RFP of starting 1st Oct and finishing early Nov, do you expect all phases of this work to be completed within 5-6 weeks?

Answer:

Yes.

Question:

1st phase - Do you have a minimum required number of survey respondents and interviews conducted, and/or do you expect to time-box this phase regardless of number of responses/ interviews

Answer:

This is not defined yet. ECMWF expects to time-box this phase. The number of people to be interviewed is expected to be 15-25.

Question:

2nd phase - Do you now expect the costing analysis to be purely focused on Atlassian configuration and licencing models, with no consideration to Atlassian suit alternatives?

Answer:

Yes.

3rd phase - Do you want information solely on costs & scope of delivery, or do you also expect an implementation plan and delivery roadmap?

Answer:

The timing will have to be discussed and agreed with ECMWF to fit with the strategy. A roadmap and implementation plan (with duration rather than precise times) would be a plus.

What is the difference between external and internal users in the ECMWF organization?

Answer:

All ECMWF staff members are considered as internal users. All other users (i.e. not ECMWF staff) are considered external.

Can one-on-one meetings be conducted (if necessary) with the Team Members chosen by ECMWF Team or should we pick (based on the provided documentation) the best representatives to do that part (i.e. managers of chosen departments)?

Answer:

Assuming this is for the survey, respondents can suggest stakeholders, but ECMWF will make sure that important stakeholders (as per ECMWF's viewpoint) are included.

Would it be possible to provide us with the current list of plugins used (or at the very least installed) on ECMWF Atlassian environments?

Answer:

Could you please elaborate and clarify what you mean by the following sentence: "The report should also offer mitigation if ECMWF moves all source code off-site (e.g. if the licence is no longer free) and (e.g. keep one source code, ...)."?

Answer:

Currently, ECMWF benefits from free Atlassian Licences, including Plugins. This is attached to the condition that we have one Open source project. ECMWF is contemplating the option of moving its source code to GitHub and would like to know the impact to the licence with Atlassian and the possible mitigation.

Do users authenticate through the Microsoft Active Directory?

Answer:

Yes, indirectly. Jira uses an OpenIdConnect based authentication provided by Keycloak. User IDs and passwords are stored in Active Directory, but not used directly by Jira.

Answer:

No, ECMWF uses Keycloak.
